# Importing Personal Property Into Nepal

# <u>DUTY-FREE ENTRY IS PERMITTED IF THE</u> FOLLOWING REQUIREMENTS ARE MET:

Shipper is a Diplomat, member of UN agency or Foreign Aid Department

### **REQUIRED DOCUMENTS:**

- ✓ Packing list in English. Details of all electronic items (i.e. Serial numbers) must be included
- Air Waybill or Bill of Lading

#### Notes:

- Shipper must be present for customs clearance
- Reasonable amounts of Perfume, Film (15 rolls), Alcohol (I Liter) and Tobacco (200 cigarettes/ 50 cigars are allowed duty free
- Electronics are considered duty-free ONLY if they are exported upon departure
- All items considered duty-free must arrive in Nepal within 6 months of shipper's arrival

#### PROHIBITED/RESTRICTED ITEMS:

- Arms and ammunition
- Narcotics
- Beef in any form
- Pornography
- Politically subversive materials
- Communications equipment must have import permit
- Ivory or other animal goods must have import permit

## **IMPORTING AUTOMOBILES**:

- Duty free for all diplomats, UN agencies and members of Foreign Aid Projects
- Automobiles must be less then 5 years old ,and comply with the EURO III standard of emissions.

#### .REQUIRED DOCUMENTS:

- ✓ Invoice for new automobiles
- ✓ Previous registrations or ownership certificates
- ✓ Certificate of Origin

#### Note:

 Shipper must include model, engine number and chassis number on all automobile customs paperwork

#### **IMPORTING PETS:**

 Pets are allowed accompanied by shipper or as unaccompanied baggage

#### **REQUIRED DOCUMENTS:**

- Health certificate issued by the concerned authority.
- ✓ Import Permit
